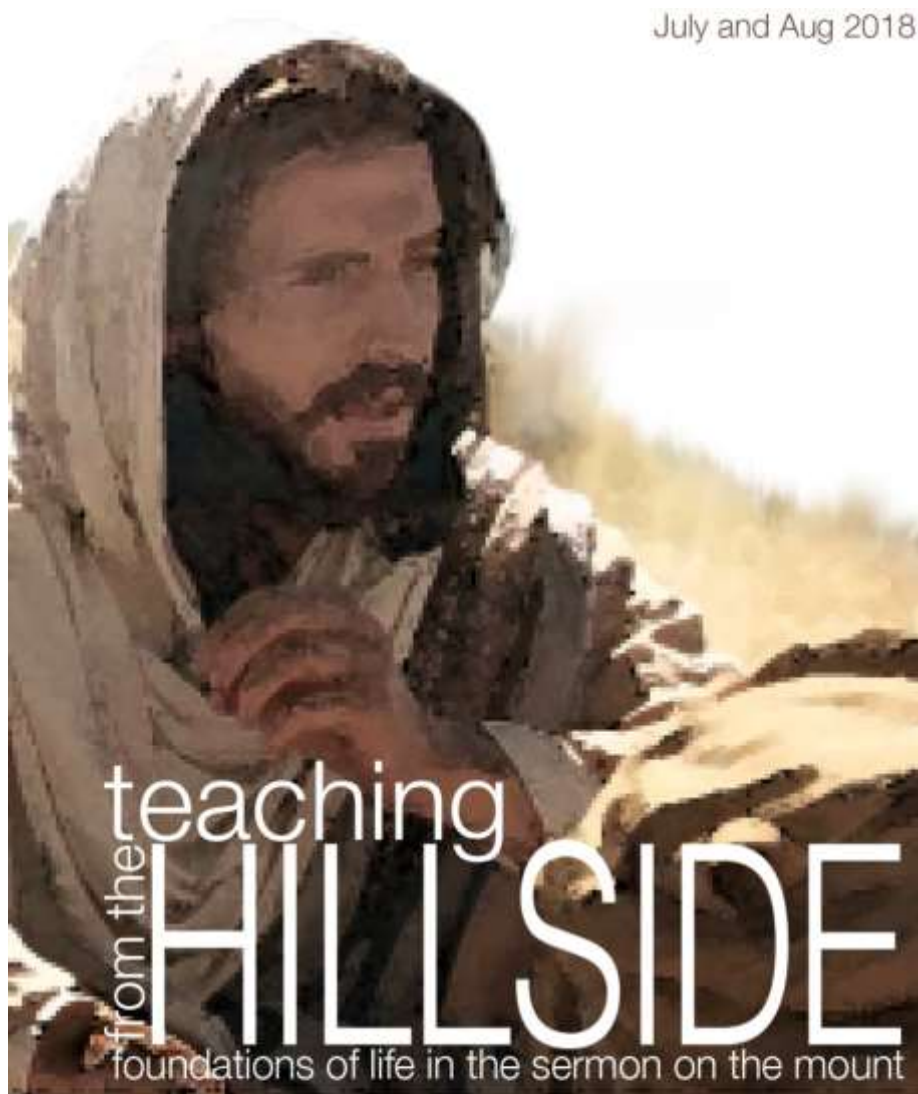

Short Term Mission Opportunity – Bolivia, February 2019

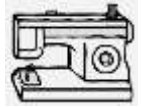
We are excited to have the opportunity to send a Wyoming Baptist Church team back to Bolivia in South America in February 2019.
