Unrest in Bolivia

Prayer request from Bruno and Kathleen Soucey -Bolivia does not often hit the news cycle in Canada so we wanted to share with you some news and prayer items. Subsequent to last Sunday's election, the results of which are being contested, many areas of Bolivia are to some degree in turmoil, with travel and daily activities essentially shut down. It is difficult for Bolivians to know (let alone for outsiders to speculate) how things will be resolved, or when. The incumbent president Evo Morales and his MAS party are not favorably inclined to submit to the opposition requests for a second round of elections. Our Canadian Baptist Mission colleagues in Bolivia - Tim and Kallie Hutton and Patty Nacho are all safe. Bill and Janice Dyck are on home assignment in Canada. Our partners at the local Baptist Church organizations, the UBB and OBADES, are also well, although gatherings for various activities have been cancelled and no staff is traveling to communities. As a result many programs are on hold. Please pray for a peaceful and speedy resolution to this conflict. Also that our church partners and staff can continue activities and safely travel as required.
